Item No. 15_29: Ph.D. Admissions, Pre-submission Seminars and reconstitution of DRCs:

In the minutes of the meeting held under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor on dated 24.07.2020, It was resolved that university will arrange to publish advertisement regarding Ph.D slots in newspapers/website by 31.08.2020. Director Research will submit the revised slots by 14th August, 2020. All chairpersons are also requested to submit the departmental information, if there is any change in the university brochure already uploaded on the admission portal of the University.

- For existing research scholar, there is no need to present pre-Ph.D seminar again upto 31st August, 2020, if already presented before closure of University due to COVID-19.
- Any existing Ph.D scholar wants to present research plan or submit his/her thesis upto 31.08.2020 & his/her normal duration/extended period expired before 31.08.2020, for all such cases, the period for submitting Ph.D thesis/research plan presentation is extended upto 31.08.2020. Others are required to follow Ph.D. Ordinance to seek any kind of extension in the period of thesis submission.
- Provision in the Ph.D ordinance for 15 days continuous presence in each semester for Part time research scholars is not applicable for even semester of academic year 2019 -20.
- No semester/continuation fee shall be charged for submission of M.Tech. Dissertation /Ph. D Thesis in the month of July,2020 & August 2020, if some one could not submit due to lockdown announced by Government. (Minutes of meeting held under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Vice chancellor on 04.5.2020)

The following amendments are proposed in Ph.D Ordinance subject to approval of Academic council.

- All eligible teachers of the department to guide Ph.D.

If number of eligible teachers available in the department is less than three, the Chairperson of DRC may co-opt Professors from outside the Department/University to have at least three members in the DRC

One Assistant Professor of the Department having Ph.D. Degree on rotation basis for a period of two years.

If number of eligible teachers available in the department is less than three, the Chairperson of DRC co-opt Professors from outside Department/University to have at least three members in the DRC

The Chairperson of the Department shall normally be the Chairperson of the DRC, if qualifies being Ph.D. If the Chairperson does not qualify, the senior most qualifying faculty member of the Department on rotation (one year at a time), who is otherwise member of the DRC may act as the Chairperson of the DRC with the approval of the Vice Chancellor.

Responsibilities of the committee

- To review the research proposal and finalize the topic of research.
- To guide the research scholar to develop the study design and methodology of research and identify the course(s) that he/she may have to do.
- progress of the research work of the research scholar.

To periodically review and assistant in the

Clause-10.2.

The DRC will evaluate the research plan proposal and her/his academic preparation and potential to carry out the work in the research proposal. DRC may constitute a subcommittee for student specific (SSC) out of DRC member with a outside expert, if needed.

The Chairperson of the Department shall normally be the Chairperson of the DRC, if qualifies being Ph.D. If the Chairperson does not qualify, the senior most qualifying faculty member of the Department on rotation (one year at a time), who is otherwise member of the DRC may act as the Chairperson of the DRC with the approval of the Vice Chancellor.

Responsibilities of the committee

- To review the research proposal and finalize the topic of research.
- To guide the research scholar to develop the study design and methodology of research and identify the course(s) that he/she may have to do.
- To periodically review and assistant in the progress of the research work of the research scholar.

Clause-10.2.

The DRC will evaluate the research plan proposal and her/his academic preparation and potential to carry out the work in the research proposal. DRC may constitute a subcommittee for student specific (SSC) out of DRC member with a outside expert, if needed.

The composition of SSC

- (i) Chairman of DRC or his/her nominee.
- (ii) Supervisor & Co-Supervisor (if appointed).
- (iii) Two Professor of the same department having specialization in the field.
- (iv) One Professor from other department (Inter-Disciplinary nature of work) of the university.
- (v) Only one Outside expert.

The department can constitute upto four student specific committees. A committee can be constituted for more than one research scholar.

The presence of outside expert is compulsory during approval/presentation of research plan & presentation of Pre-Ph.D. seminar of Ph.D. thesis.

The comments of experts shall be taken on the progress of work of the research scholar every time.

Expert may be called in the university during progress report evaluation of a particular semester without paying TA/DA/ honorarium her/him. He may joined on-line also if committee feels. (Refer clause 11.1 to 11.4)

Clause-11.6

A research student can submit her/his thesis only on having at least two research papers out of her/his Ph.D. research wok published/accepted in SCI/SCIE/SCOPUS/UGC listed journals.

Clause-11.6

A research student can submit her/his thesis only on having at least two research papers out of her/his Ph.D. research work published/accepted in web of Science collection, which is a part of the UGC - CARE List (Group II).

Provided further that only the candidate and his/her Supervisors should be the sole authors of such research papers.

Notwithstanding anything contained therein, a candidate may publish more research papers over and above the minimum requirement of 02 including any other person among the authors in addition to his/her Supervisors. However, under such conditions he/she has to furnish a certificate that such published work has not been used for the award of any other Diploma/Degree from the DCRUST or any other Institution/Organization.

Note: Above clauses will be applicable to Research scholars admitted after circulation of minutes of 15th meeting of academic council.

Above proposal, regarding initiation of Ph. D admission for odd semester (2020-21), relaxation to Ph. D research scholar and amendment in Ph. D Ordinance, deliberated and approved by Academic Council.

In addition of the above, Dean Academic Affairs pointed out the followings and approved by the Academic Council after discussion.

- Co-supervisor may be appointed in between the period of recommendation of research plan by DRC/SSC and Pre Ph.D seminar subject to the condition that research scholar can not submit his/her Ph.D thesis before two years after the date of recommendation of appointment of Co supervisor by DRC/SSC.
- Supervisor/Co-supervisor should not to be in blood relationship with research scholar i.e. research scholar should not be his/her wife, husband, son, daughter, wife's brother and sister, brother's son and daughter, sister's son and daughter, first cousin, husband brother and sister, brother nephew, grandson & daughter.

Above two amendments in the Ph.D. ordinace shall be applicable to all research scholars including already registered.
