Amendment to Admission Policy 2024

Inclusion of Benefits for Students from Disadvantageous/ Poor Backgrounds and Local Regions

Reference: Admission Policy # JU/Reg./2023/12294 Dated: 5.12.2023

Introduction:

In recognition of the diverse socioeconomic backgrounds amongst prospective students, JECRC University hereby amends the existing Admission Policy 2024 to foster inclusivity and provide equitable opportunities for all applicants.

Definitions:

Disadvantageous Backgrounds: Refers to students coming from economically disadvantaged households, as determined by the criteria of household income. Candidates belonging to EWS Category, OBC Non Creamy Layer, and SC / ST who have an annual family income lesser than Rs.3 Lakhs (Three Lakhs) per annum from all possible sources shall come under this category.

Local Regions: Denotes geographical areas within close proximity to the University, typically including surrounding communities or districts.

Provisions:

The University shall provide "Chairperson's Fellowship" in the form of need-based financial aid to students from disadvantageous backgrounds, with the aim of mitigating financial barriers to higher education and promoting socioeconomic diversity. The candidate shall be required to submit such documents from district level competent authorities as may be considered necessary for deciding that he/she is fit for awarding the Chairperson's Fellowship.

Eligible students shall receive a 15% concession in the tuition fee. A maximum of fresh 50 (Fifty) Chairperson's Fellowship per annum will be awarded.

Renewal of the scholarship is conditional upon maintaining CGPA above 8.00 in all semesters without having any compartments in any subject and a minimum of 75% attendance in each subject.

Likewise, special scholarships shall be established for students from local regions, recognizing their contribution to the University's ethos and their potential to positively impact their communities upon graduation. These scholarships may be merit-based or need-based.

Additionally, dedicated support services shall be provided to students from disadvantaged backgrounds and local regions, including academic advising, counselling, and access to resources aimed at facilitating their academic and personal success.

The effectiveness of these amendments shall be periodically reviewed by the University administration, with feedback solicited from students, faculty, and staff. Adjustments shall be made as necessary to ensure alignment with the University's mission of promoting diversity, equity, and inclusion.

This bears the approval of the competent authority, and shall come into force with immediate effect.
